

Game	Rules	Betting	Examples
Draw	All cards are hidden, but players may trade (up to 4 cards with an ace) to achieve a better hand	Initial buy-in bet, second round of betting after card exchange	5-card draw, 7-card draw
Stud	Players hold hidden and shown cards	Initial buy-in, round of betting after each card is dealt	5-card stud, 7-card stud
Texas Hold 'Em	Players hide 2 cards of their own and share 5 community cards with the table	Double-blind initial bet, three rounds of betting as community cards are displayed	Played as the main game at the <i>World Series of Poker</i>
Omaha Hold 'Em	Players hold 4 cards, but can only use 2 and the 5 community cards to create a hand	Identical to Texas Hold 'Em	No-limit and limited pot games are played
Omaha Hi Lo	Card configuration identical to Omaha Hold 'Em, but players make a high hand and a low hand using all 4 hole cards	Betting is the same as Hold 'Em games	Also known as Omaha 8
3 Card Poker	The player and the dealer receive 3 hidden cards. Dealer's cards exposed after betting. Player automatically wins if dealer doesn't have a Queen or better.	Single ante	Table or video poker game
Caribbean Stud	5-card stud game between player and dealer	Single ante and optional progressive side bet	Table or video poker game
Wild Card	Often used with stud games; wild cards will be stated before the hand is dealt	Normal betting rules apply for the type of poker being played	Follow the Queen (card that follows face-up Queen is wild)
